Dear 8<sup>th</sup> Grade Parent/Guardian:

This school year is flying by, but please read this letter carefully. It is time to begin thinking of our end of the year activities. For our class trip we will go to **Dorney Park**, and it will be a long day. We will leave the school a little after 8:00 in the morning and will return to the school a little before 8:00 in the evening. The cost of the trip is \$90.00. This includes the price of admission, a catered lunch in the picnic grove (hamburgers, fried chicken, baked ziti, a salad, ice cream, and soda), transportation to and from the park, and the required class trip t-shirt. Students going on the trip must wear their DMS class trip T-shirt while at Dorney Park except when visiting the water park. Students may wear bathing suits in the water park.
